Quick Facts

- The two seniors-only events feature 156 players from 29 states and 11 countries.
- The AJGA Senior Boys and Girls Championships are 36-hole, stroke play events.
- The event is only for high school seniors who have not signed a National Letter of Intent with a college or university.
- More than 70 college coaches are expected to attend the tournament to recruit players.
- After the 2013 seniors-only events, 58 percent of the players in the field went on to play college golf.

Unsigned Seniors

This tournament is specifically for high school seniors who have not signed a National Letter of Intent with a college or university. It is a final chance for these players to showcase their skills to the more than 70 college coaches who are expected to be in attendance. From the players in the field for the 2013 seniors events, 58 percent are now playing college golf.

This year will mark the third time the seniors-only events have been hosted in Las Vegas. The tournaments always fall at the end of the year and are staffed by full-time AJGA employees.
